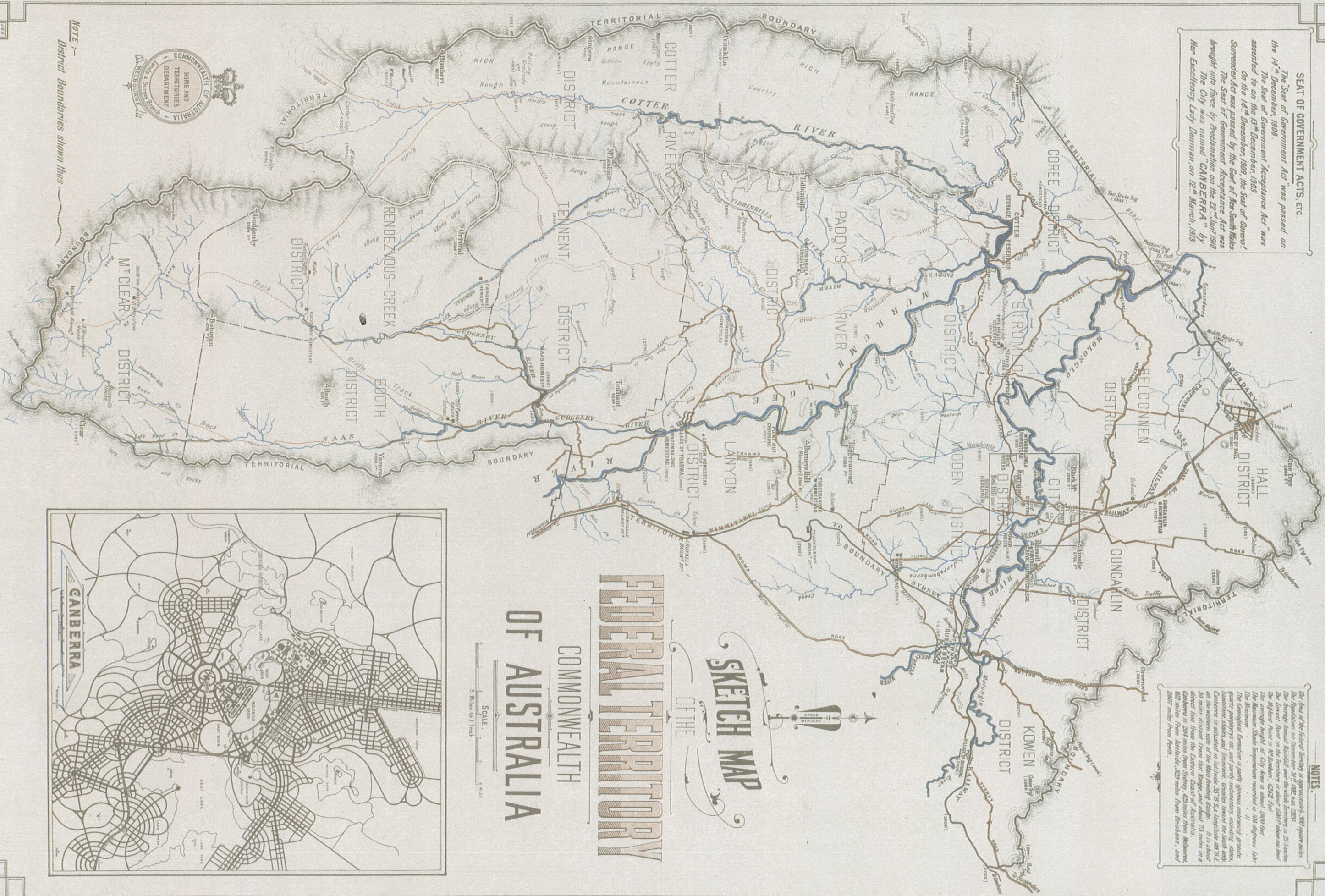


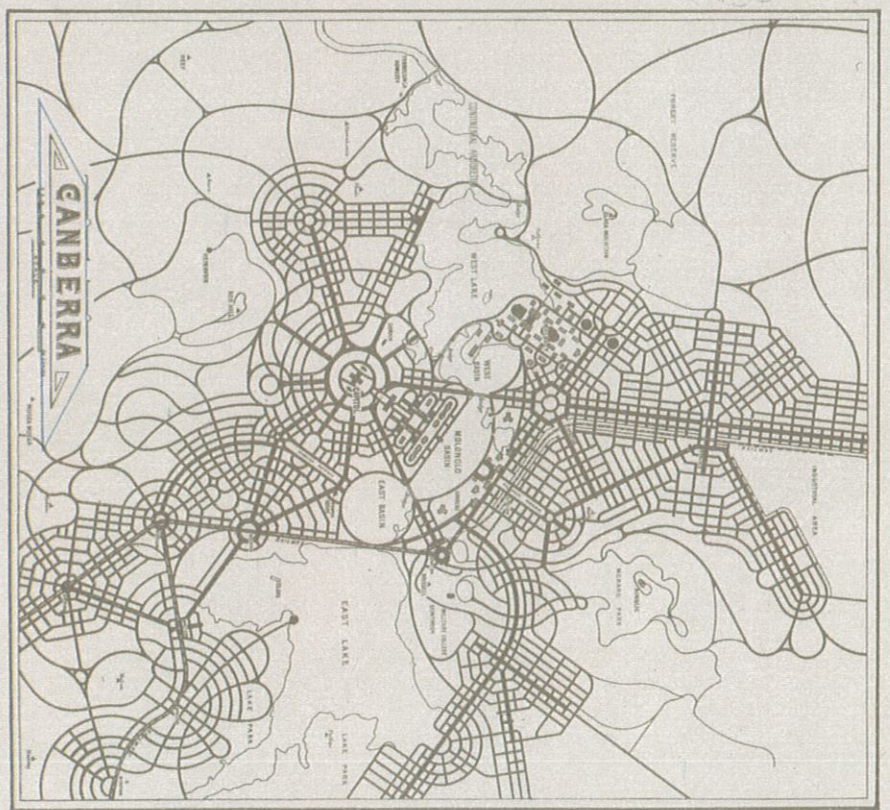
SEAT OF GOVERNMENT ACTS, ETC.
 The Seat of Government Act was passed on the 14th December, 1908.
 The Seat of Government "Acceptance Act" was assented to on the 13th December, 1909.
 On the 14th December, 1909, the Seat of Government Act was passed by the Govt of New South Wales.
 The Seat of Government Acceptance Act was brought into force by Proclamation on the 22nd Jan'y 1910.
 The City was named "CANBERRA" by Her Excellency Lady Denman, on 12th March, 1913.

NOTES.
 The Area of the Federal Territory is approximately 480 square miles.
 The Population on December 31st, 1920, was 22,000.
 The average annual Rainfall over the whole Territory is 25.5 inches.
 The lowest Point in the Territory is about 500 ft above sea level.
 The highest Point is Mt. Sinker, 6,502 Feet.
 The average height of City Area is about 1,800 feet.
 The minimum State temperature recorded is 104 degrees Fahr.
 The maximum State temperature recorded is 118 degrees Fahr.
 The Geological formation is partly igneous, embracing granite, quartz, porphyry, etc., and partly sedimentary, including shales, sandstone, calcareous limestone, Gneiss (near the Snowy Mts), on the western side of the Main Ranges Range. It is about 50 miles distant from the Eastern Coast of Australia.
 Canberra is 204 miles from Sydney, 42 miles from Melbourne, 312 miles from Adelaide, 253 miles from Brisbane, and 2,807 miles from Perth.
