

## **MOLONGLO GORGE AND RESERVE**

*Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> November 9.30am-3.30pm*



This walk will examine how geology and geomorphology have underpinned the evolution of the gorge and its present status as a natural geographic corridor, influencing biodiversity and cultural development. To be led by National Trust member, Robert Abell. A short day excursion. Starts at 9.30am at the car park near the gorge entrance and finishes at approx. 3.30pm. Distance approx. 7kms but maybe a few kilometers longer if participants wish to return via tracks through Kowen Forest. Packed lunch to be brought by participant. Number limited to 20 (inclusive of the leader). Provision of wine/soft drinks etc. and nibbles at the end of the excursion (at carpark).

**Cost:** \$20 members, \$25 non members.

How to get there: Go along Pialligo Avenue (past airport); turn left into Sutton Rd and then right into Kowen Rd. Follow signs to Molonglo Gorge Forest Park where walk begins near the gorge entrance.
